Carla Caldwell is a native of Augusta, GA. Her parents were Army and she credits her military upbringing with setting the foundation for community involvement. Carla began volunteering at Golden Harvest Food Bank at the age of 13. She successfully coordinated her first food drive for disaster relief victims of Hurricane Andrew at 14 years old. "I remember when Golden Harvest Food Bank setup the empty tractor trailer in the parking lot of the old Hardees on Washington Rd., and thinking to myself, "can I really do this" but with the help of some other teen volunteers we filled it, sorted and shipped it off to the victims."

She went on to work with Habitat for Humanity in college; afterwards she moved to Atlanta and continued to volunteer with Inner-Strength, a program for inner city youth. It was through Inner-Strength and her corporate job that she became familiar with United Way. She began serving as an ambassador for United Way in 2000.

In 2004, she returned to the CSRA, enrolled in Augusta State University's MPA Program and a year later began working for Aiken County's Planning & Development Department as the Subdivision Planner, where she became familiar with Project VISION. "Project VISION days became my favorite work days. Oftentimes, people think of how much our project means to the recipient, but it also means a great deal to the volunteers." "I am delighted to have the opportunity to be the director of a results oriented program that enhances the quality of life for members of the community."

Carla considers Aiken her second home, "Aiken is so much a part of me that I even learned to ride horses." She obtained a Bachelors of Science in Political Science from Georgia Southern University and Master of Public Administration from Augusta State University.

AACE Annual Meeting Update: General Peter Pace, USMC (Ret.) is the Keynote Speaker

General Peter Pace retired from active duty on October 1, 2007 after more than 40 years of service in the United States Marine Corps.

Pace was sworn in as sixteenth chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff on Sep. 30, 2005. In this capacity, he served as the principal military advisor to the President, the Secretary of Defense, the National Security Council and the Homeland Security Council. Prior to becoming chairman, he served as vice chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff. Pace holds the distinction of being the first Marine to have served in either of these positions.
