"Realities of War: Lessons of Dynamic Leadership"
Major Shane F. Liptak

Major Liptak is the Chief of the Information Assurance Division at US Army's School of Information Technology at Fort Gordon, GA.

Prior to this assignment, Major Liptak was deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom as the Chief Information Technology Officer of the 3rd Brigade (Rakkasans), 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault) at Fort Campbell, KY.

Major Liptak's previous assignments include Commander, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 18th Aviation Brigade, Fort Bragg, NC; Brigade Logistics Officer, Brigade Comptroller, 18th Aviation Brigade; Brigade Logistics Officer, Brigade Comptroller, 101st Aviation Brigade; Quickfix Platoon Leader, 6th Battalion, 101st Aviation Regiment, 101st Aviation Brigade; Allied Shops Platoon Leader, 2nd Battalion, 2nd Aviation Regiment, 2nd Infantry Division, United States Forces Korea; Operations Sergeant and Interrogator/German Linguist, A Company, 6th Psyop Battalion, Fort Bragg, NC.

Major Liptak enlisted in the US Army in 1991 and was awarded a two-year ROTC scholarship in 1994. He was commissioned in 1996 and graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Political Science from Methodist University, NC. He has also attended the Aviation Officer Basic Course, the Army Rotary Wing Aviators Course, the UH-60 Blackhawk Qualification Course, the Aviation Captains Career Course, the Combined Arms and Services Staff School, the Information Systems Managers Course, the Total Army Instructor Training Course, the Contracting Officers Representative Course, the Human Resource Management Course, the Certified Information Systems Security Course (CISSP), and both the US Army Airborne and Air Assault Schools.

Major Liptak is a rated army aviator in the UH-60L Blackhawk and the OH-58A/C Kiowa. He also holds certifications in Security+ and Network+ and is patiently waiting for his CISSP exam results. Major Liptak's awards include the Bronze Star Medal, the Army Meritorius Service Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster, the Army Commendation Medal with Oak Leaf Cluster, and the Army Achievement Medal.

Major Liptak is married to the former Shannon Livingston from Carbon Hill, AL and they have a wonderful seven-year-old daughter named Chloe.
